Notes:

1. To be eligible for a Deep East Texas A&M Club (DETAMC) scholarship, a student must live in the geographical area containing the Post Offices of Gladewater, Hallsville, Judson, Kilgore, Longview, and White Oak and must attend one of those high schools.
2. Scholarships are awarded annually to needy and worthy high school seniors in the area who have been accepted by TAMU.
3. The student must attend TAMU, College Station, Texas to receive funds provided by this scholarship.
4. Scholarship awards are selected by a committee made up by members of the DETAMC and are normally presented at the Aggie Muster ceremonies on April 21st of each year.
5. Student selected for scholarship awards will be notified prior to April 21st.
6. Scholarships awarded, depending on available funds, are as follows:
 - a. One to two Jim Cockrell Scholarships
 - b. One Dr. Peggy Coghlan Scholarship
 - c. One to four Club Scholarships.
7. The scholarship is for one year (two semesters) with half being paid at the beginning of each of the two semesters.
8. The funds are paid by the DETAMC Treasurer directly to TAMU (not through the student).
9. The 2nd semester funds may not be advanced to the 1st semester and paid along with the 1st semester funds. However, at the student's choice, the scholarship may be delayed to a subsequent school year if the student has more scholarship funds than needed for the 1st year. If the student selects a delay, the student must still be enrolled at TAMU to receive the delayed funds. The delayed funds will remain at face value, and no interest will be applied.

Submitting your application:

The application can be typed in, depending on the student's available software, or it can be filled in by hand.

Please submit the following to be considered for the Deep East Texas A&M Club (DETAMC) scholarship:

1. Completed application form
2. Letters of recommendation from your high school faculty or counselor
3. **For counselor use:** Please submit a copy of the applicant's transcript and a copy of ACT/SAT scores.

This application is due on April 1, 2019. Applications submitted after the deadline may not be accepted.
