- 3. High School transcripts signed by the principal must accompany the application.**
- 4. Selection will be based on need, scholastic ability, and leadership activities in FFA, 4-H, community and school activities.**
- 5. Applicants must have taken the ACT or SAT and the official results must be attached to the application.**
- 6. Applicant must maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA while in college and carry a minimum of 12 hours each semester.**
- 7. A picture suitable for publicity must accompany application.**
