Gladewater ISD Grow Your Own Teacher Program



Rationale

It is well noted and widely known that the current pool of traditionally certified teacher candidates and the number of students in traditional teacher education programs is low. Through Gladewater ISD's approved District of Innovation Plan, we look to help our position by "growing our own teachers" by focusing on the recruitment and training of three specific groups:

- Degreed, non-certified individuals pursuing teacher certification through alternative methods
- Non-degreed, non-certified GISD employees pursing college degrees and teacher certification
- GHS juniors and seniors interested in pursuing education degrees and teacher certification.

In order to ensure the success of the selected individuals in this program and high-quality instruction, GISD will provide the following support to candidates hired under a GISD Grow Your Own Program District of Innovation Permit:

- The campus principal and/or director will create a personal professional development plan for each teacher.
- The candidate will be supported through the implementation of NIET's TAP Program.
- When possible, lesson plans will be created in partnership with certified teachers in the same field.
- Additional professional development and support for classroom management will be provided.
- A designated mentor will be assigned.
- Classroom observation opportunities will be available.

This innovation will allow Gladewater ISD to consider broader applicant pools and to broaden the district's course offerings. It will also allow Gladewater ISD to fill hard-to-staff positions while maintaining a high quality of instruction.
