Mr. Cockerell made a motion to approve the 2023-2024 school year tax rate and Mr. Thompson seconded the motion. The motion passes 4-0.

Dr. Clark asked Matt McIntosh to come speak to the Board regarding the damage done to Weldon Elementary's auditorium due to the recent storms in June. A portion of the roof was peeled back and the thermostat also had malfunctioned resulting in black mold forming throughout the auditorium. Mr. McIntosh spoke of the damage and items needing to be repaired. No action was taken at this time.

The Board entered into executive session to consider personnel matters as allowed by the Texas Government Code §551.074 involving the appointment of a candidate to fill the Place 5 vacancy.

Upon coming out of executive session, Mrs. Budro made a motion to adjourn the Special Board meeting of September 11, 2023 and Mr. Thompson seconded the motion. The motion passes 4-0.
