

Gladewater ISD: COVID Health Protocol

(2022-2023)



Gladewater ISD will follow guidance from the Centers of Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the Texas Education Agency (TEA), and state and local health agencies. This document will be updated as the TEA guidance changes. Our priority is the safety of our students, staff, and community.

Student Protocol

Gladewater ISD must exclude students from attending school in person who have or are suspected of having COVID-19, and must immediately notify parents if this is determined while on campus. As noted in the rule, exclusion shall continue until the conditions for re-entry are met:

- ***For children with symptoms, at least 5 days have passed since symptom onset, and fever free, and other symptoms have improved.***
- ***Children who test positive for COVID-19 but do not have any symptoms must stay home until at least 5 days after the day they were tested.***

Parents must ensure they do not send a child to school on campus if the child has COVID-19 symptoms or is test-confirmed with COVID-19, until the conditions for re-entry are met.
