If you meet one of these requirements and have the correct proof your child is eligible for Pre-K.

<input type="checkbox"/>	2. EDG (Eligibility Disability Group) Number	-Card or proof of number SSI, TANF, CHILD SUPPORT, FOOD STAMPS
<input type="checkbox"/>	3. Homeless, as defined 42 USC Section 11302, regardless of the residence of either parent of the child	-Documentation indicating that the child's residence status is considered homeless
<input type="checkbox"/>	4. Child of an active duty member of the armed forces of the US, including the state military forces or a reserve component of the armed forces who is ordered to active duty by proper authority	-Visual verification of parent's Military ID (Copies cannot be made of Military ID's)
<input type="checkbox"/>	5. Child of a member of the armed forces of the US, including the state military forces or a reserve component of the armed forces who was injured or killed while service on active duty	Administrator or Registrar initial and date OR -Copy of Military Statement of Service

Child of a peace officers, firefighters, and first responders who have demonstrated remarkable courage and heroism in serving and protecting their communities throughout the state and have been awarded the Star of Texas Award	-Certificate, letter from the Governor or state representative (House or Senate)

Child is, or ever has been, in the conservatorship of DFPS following an adversary hearing held as provided by Section 262.201, Family Code	-Enrollment letter from DFPS, stating that the child is eligible for PK services; OR -Documentation from DFPS stating that child is currently in Foster Care.
<input type="checkbox"/>	8. Educationally Disadvantaged (eligible to participate in the NSLP)	-One current month payroll check stub(s) or other eligible documents confirming eligibility.
