



We are very excited to welcome our students back to GHS on Wed., Aug. 12th! We have missed them! Students MUST wear their masks in the building at all times except when they are eating.

Parents—take your child's temperature before they leave for school. Keep them home if it is 100 degrees or higher. Students will be allowed in the building at 7:30.

Only visitors with school business and masks will be allowed in the building. No lunch visitors. Students won't be able to walk out and get their lunch from parents.

Bus Riders: All students must wear a mask while on the bus. Staff will check temps. at the bus ramp and make sure masks are on before they enter the building.

Front Drop Off: Staff will check temps. at the front door and make sure masks are on before they enter the building.

Student Drivers: The doors near the student parking lot, gym, and auditorium will remain locked ALL Day. Male athletes will walk down the sidewalk to the boys' locker room door near the tennis courts. A coach will take their temp. and go directly into the gym. Honeybears and Cheer Leaders will walk down the side walk to the girls' locker room door. Mrs. Clark and Mrs. Smith will take their temps. Student drivers who are not athletes, Honeybears, or cheer leaders, will walk around to the front door to enter. Staff will be on duty checking temps. and masks.

Breakfast: 9th & 10th graders will eat breakfast in the cafeteria and wait for the 1st bell. 11th & 12th graders will get their breakfast and take it to the west side stands in the gym to eat and/or wait for the 1st bell.

Administrators will call parents of students who refuse to wear masks. If the parent refuses to enforce their child wearing a mask, then that student will be moved to online learning.

Masks stay on through dismissal and on the bus ramp.

Students cannot use the water fountains. They must bring their own water bottle.

A hand-sanitizing station has been installed in every classroom.
