VARSITY FOOTBALL

All season tickets for the 2020 Football Season have been frozen until next year. (2021/2022) Before the 2021 football season begins, 2019 season ticket holders will have first choice at renewing season ticket purchases. Thanks for your patience in this trying time.

- Absolutely no PASSES will be accepted. PER DISTRICT EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE
- Everyone must have a ticket to enter. NO EXCEPTIONS
- ALL seating is General Admission
- All tickets will be PRE-SALE, **No Tickets Sold At The Gate**
- All Tickets will be \$5.00 each.
- Student Athletes / Participants will pick up tickets for family and friends on the following schedule.

TICKETS FOR CURRENT WEEK'S GAMES, HOME OR AWAY, WILL BE SOLD AS FOLLOWS:

- MONDAYS
 - ONLY VARSITY FOOTBALL PLAYERS may purchase 4 tickets for that week's game. Tickets will be purchased in the main office at GHS.
- TUESDAYS
 - BAND, CHEERLEADER & HONEYBEAR students may purchase 4 tickets for that week's game. Tickets will be purchased in the main office at GHS.
 - During lunch the student body will be able to purchase a single ticket.
 - **Note:** Band & Honeybear students will not travel to out of town games.
- WEDNESDAYS
 - The teachers and staff will be able to purchase tickets in the High School Office from 8:00 am - 10:30am.
 - Remaining tickets will be sold to the public from 10am until gone or 3:00 pm, whichever comes first. Tickets will be sold at the west entrance foyer of Bill Waters Gymnasium.

THERE WILL BE NO CHANGES IN THE WEEKLY TICKET SALES SCHEDULE.

NO ONE WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE FIELD BEFORE, DURING OR AFTER THE GAME EXCEPT FOR PLAYERS, COACHES & OFFICIALS AND OTHER APPROVED PERSONS.

- All seating will be General Admission
- Stadium will be operated at 50% capacity.
- Home and visitor gates will be open. Handicapped gate on the home side will be open.
- ABSOLUTELY NO PASSES WILL BE ACCEPTED
- Tickets will be sold at the gate, \$3.00 for adults, \$2.00 for students.

AFTER 50% OF VISITORS SIDE STADIUM CAPACITY IS REACHED, NO OTHER FANS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE STADIUM.
